Every day, Uganda produces over 600 tons of plastic waste, with only 12% recycled. At the same time, 70% of public schools lack adequate desks and chairs, forcing students to learn in difficult conditions. We turn this challenge into opportunity by recycling HDPE and PET plastics into strong, termite-proof desks and chairs that provide better learning environments while protecting our planet.
